OPEN DOOR POLICY: The Boys & Girls Club has an Open Door Policy for members in grades 6 and up. This policy allows members to check-in and check-out of the Club as they please. It is the responsibility of the child AND the parent/guardian to determine, understand and enforce whatever arrival and departure methods they see fit. Supervision is not provided once the child leaves our facility. Please note that youth are not allowed on the Club's grounds unless they are signed in and participating in Club activities.

____ (Please initial indicating your consent). I give permission for my child to participate in the Open Door Policy. By signing this form, I understand I give my child permission to leave the Boys & Girls Club building during program hours unsupervised by program staff and release the Boys & Girls Club of Oyster Bay-East Norwich from liability from any injury, loss, or theft incurred by the child(ren) while participating in the Open Door Policy.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS: To maintain a constructive atmosphere and for safety purposes, the Boys & Girls Club of Oyster Bay-East Norwich must establish rules for riding the bus. Consistent behavior problems on the bus will result in a conference being held with the director, parent/guardian and child to review the Club rules and to discuss possible solutions. In extreme circumstances, including serious discipline problems, transportation privileges may be revoked. After a conference with parents and the child, the child may, at the sole discretion of the director, be withdrawn from the program without a refund of tuition.

RULES FOR RIDING THE BUS:

- 1.) When boarding or exiting the bus, children are to cross in front of bus, 2.) Wait until the bus comes to a full stop before attempting to board or exit, 3.) After boarding the bus, go directly to a seat and remain there until the bus comes to a complete stop, 4.) Follow the same rules of conduct and speech that you are expected to follow in school and at the Boys & Girls Club, 5.) Don't eat, drink or smoke on the bus, 6.) Keep feet and sharp objects off seats at all times, 7.) Keep the bus clean-do not litter or be destructive, 8.) Keep your head, hands, and feet inside the bus, 9.) Refrain from talking to the driver while the bus is in motion, 10.) Understand that the driver is the adult in charge on the bus, 11.) No person other than a Boys & Girls Club member, staff person, or other individual designated to supervise the youngsters shall be permitted on the bus.

WISEENGINEERING: Your child will participate in hands-on engineering design activities using cognitive thinking, problem solving and collaboration with peers. Youth will be using the **WISEngineering** online learning environment. The environment is secure from the outside world, but open to the Boys & Girls Club and to our colleagues at Hofstra University. Youth will be able to share photos and perhaps videos of their work with each other, their parents and family.
