Chess Club

Back by Popular Demand in January – Saturdays, 1/12, 1/19, 1/26

Members of the Long Island Chess Club will be here at the Club on Saturdays to teach members the fundamentals of the game of chess. Studies have shown that chess improves academic performance, concentration, logical thinking and teaches responsibility for ones decisions. Weekly classes will feature a short lecture about chess strategy followed by guided play, designed to present chess as a constructive form of recreation that the children enjoy.



Members must register for each session in advance. Members can sign up as they go for the sessions. The program will run from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Members can sign up for all three sessions or just 1 hour. Members may bring a nut-free snack with them or singles/change to use the vending machines.
