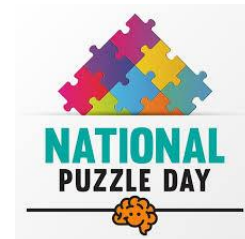

Youth of the Year and Junior Youth of the Year

The Youth of the Year is Boys & Girls Clubs of America's "signature effort to foster a new generation of leaders, fully prepared to live and lead in a diverse, global and integrated world economy." The recipient is selected based on their character, willingness to help, and positive attitude. They show dedication to character and citizenship, living a healthy lifestyle and to academic success. The Youth of the Year title is the most prestigious Club honor bestowed upon a young person. The selected individual exemplifies Boys & Girls Club values and is proof of the impact the Club makes in transforming young people lives. Each year, one outstanding youth is selected to represent the organization at local events, to compete for the title of New York State's Youth of the Year, and may progress to the regional and national competition. In 2020, the Club began awarding the title of Junior Youth of the Year to a teen nominee age 11 to 13, in celebration of their leadership development and commitment to volunteering at the Club. In order to compete for these titles, teens must regularly volunteer at the Club, demonstrate the characteristics mentioned above and have been a member for two consecutive years prior to their nomination. Once nominated, teens are interviewed by a panel of judges and a youth is selected.
