- Before School Program, members in grades K-6, enjoy a light, healthy breakfast and participate in fun, age-appropriate activities before the start of each school day. The program begins at 7:00 a.m., and transportation is provided to Roosevelt Elementary and Vernon Middle Schools.
- After School Program provides children in grades K-5 with a safe, fun environment with caring staff members and friends. Transportation is provided to the Clubhouse from Roosevelt and Vernon Schools at dismissal. The program operates Monday-Friday, from dismissal time until 6:30 p.m. each day school is in session.

### Chess Club - Saturdays, 12 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., May 4<sup>th</sup> and May 18<sup>th</sup>

Members of the Long Island Chess Club will teach the fundamentals of the game of chess.
